
Gas Target Model 2011

"One of the key challenges in creating an integrated market is to put in place effective rules for facilitating cross-border trading and market integration between Member States."


"Sufficient and accessible interconnection will promote liquidity in hub-based trading, which in turn will assist with the development of marketbased balancing."

"The idea of the integrated energy market is to promote competition in the European wholesale markets and facilitate new entry to compete against the incumbents in supplying gas."






Belux Market Integration

Belux Market Integration

Phase 1: BeLux integrated market zone launched on 1/10/2015

- First cross border market integration in EU, uniting the H-gas market of Belgium and Luxemburg
- In this first transitory phase, Fluxys Belgium operates as Balancing operator for the BeLux Area

Phase 2: Balansys to become cross-border Balancing operator for the BeLux area

- Performance of the market-based balancing of the BeLux area
- Performance of regulatory tasks: drafting, designing and submitting of regulated documents and balancing tariff to both national regulators
- Concluding Balancing Agreements with Network

16 October 2019: ACER approves Compliance Program (needed to switch to Phase 2)

- Aiming at ensuring non-discrimination, equal treatment of market participants as well as preserving the confidentiality of commercially sensitive data
- All Balansys employees, Belgian/Luxemburg TSO's employees and subcontractors working for Balansys need to comply with Compliance Program



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
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Balansys

TSOs



Except for commercial balancing, TSOs will still perform all activities i.e.:

- Capacity management:
 - Commercialisation
 - Nomination handling
 - Allocations
 - Metering
- Network operational management:
 - Physical balancing
 - Incident management
 - Emergency measures




Balansys will perform tasks related to commercial balancing:

- Aggregation of Network Users imbalance positions in Belgium and Luxembourg & communication of imbalance positions to Network Users
- Gas transactions (sales & purchases) on exchange platform (for balancing purposes only)
- Regulatory topics related to Balansys regulated documents, regulated balancing tariff and contacts with regulators on market-based balancing topics
- Invoicing of balancing regulated tariffs, i.e. daily imbalance charges & neutrality charge




Aggregation of Network Users imbalance positions in Belgium and Luxembourg & communication of imbalance positions to Network Users





Gas transactions (sales & purchases) on exchange platform

Balansys will perform gas sales / purchases transactions in case the market players do not respect their obligation to remain within the limits defined by the balancing rules:



Balansys will perform these transactions on an anonymous platform on ZTP:

- Goal of these transactions is not trading, only compensation of residual balancing of the integrated BeLux area
- These transactions will also provide Balansys with a reference price for invoicing of quantities to market players for which such transactions had to be done, in accordance with the BAL NC






Invoicing of balancing regulated tariffs, i.e. daily imbalance charges & neutrality charge

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Market consultation Balansys 12th of Nov till 11th of Dec

1. Counterparty risk management

- Stricter review and actions taken in every case where there is a deviation from the balancing agreement concerning invoicing and payment.

2. Invoicing

Communication of an overview of the consolidated invoices to the Network Users, including a summary indicating the balance to be paid to Balansys or to be reimbursed to the Network User.

3. Imbalance pooling

- The Imbalance Pooling Service can henceforward be subscribed via the service request in writing (letter, fax, or e-mail) to the balancing operator by means of the dedicated service request form.

4. Alignment of the definitions and clauses in the BA, BC and BP

- Alignment with the definitions in the regulatory documents of its Belgian TSO, Fluxys Belgium.
- The term "Network User" is from now on a coherent term in all Balansys' regulatory documents.

5. Technical changes and material error corrections

 Following the CREG's decision on the proposed changes in 2018, some adjustments were required and added, a.o. clarifications for the application of Force Majeure and suspension in the event of an incident or emergency.





Technical changes	No	§6.2 proposed addition of the following sentence: 'Force Majeure invoked by one or both TSOs that hinders the provision of Transmission Services by one or both TSOs.' The proposed wording lacks sufficient clarity and a TSO invoking a Force Majeure does not in itself constitute the cause of a FM event. The proposed wording does not tie to any objective criteria but opens space for a contract party's sole discretion. On this basis, we trust that the sentence will be deleted.	In order to clarify, the sentence has been changed accordingly: ' or, Force Majeure invoked by one or both TSOs under the STA and/or CCF that hinders the provision of Transmission Services by one or both TSOs.'
Technical changes	No	§6.6(ii) Proposed insertion of following wording: 'unless Network User is itself affected by an event of Force Majeure under the conditions of Article 6.1.' We suggest the proposed insertion is deleted on the basis that it would lead to uncertainty and potentially a prolonged legal process to demonstrate whether a Network User is affected, given that the impact of a FM on Network User could be indirect as well as direct and based on a number of variable factors.	As the addition is inserted in order to protect the Network User for events clearly described in Article 6.1, the insertion will not be deleted.

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
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


Contractual structure

- Balancing Programme: indicative commercial document detailing balancing regime & services

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

- Payment of invoices -> new bank account: IBAN LU58 0030 5451 3226 0000
 - First invoice around 10th July
- Creditworthiness requirements to be fulfilled
 - Have an acceptable credit rating

- Submit a collateral of which the amount shall be at least equal to the sum of the:
 - Average amount of the net-off of the Balancing Monthly and self-billing Fee of the Network User and



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
